IMPORTANT UPDATE For St. Joseph's Hospital Labor & Delivery

CURRENT VISITING GUIDELINES

Out of an abundance of caution, and to help mitigate exposure should a patient that meets the COVID-19 screening criteria enter one of our facilities, St. Joseph's Health Hospital will restrict visitors of our patients and colleagues effective today 03/13/2020.

The following quidelines are in effect until further notice:

- 1. 1 visitor per patient at a time for no longer than 1-2 hours.
- 2. No visitors under 14 years of age.
- **3.** Do not visit if you are sick.

ALL visitors should:

- **4.** Wash their hands with soap and water frequently, or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- **5.** Use a tissue to cover any coughs and sneezes.
- **6.** Assess their own health and if at risk for illness, or have any symptoms, stay home.

CURRENT LABOR & DELIVERY GUIDELINES

OB regulations:

- **Support persons showing up sick will not be allowed to stay, they will be asked to leave ***
 - 1. Laboring patient (LD and Birth Place)
 - a. Two coaches may stay with the patient 24/7 (over 14 years old)
 - b. No other visitors will be allowed. This includes children under 14.
 - 2. Labor & Delivery Operating Room
 - a. One coach will be allowed in the C-section room
 - b. The coach may remain with the patient in the C-section room and in the recovery room (the second support person may be here)
 - c. No other visitors are allowed. This includes children under 14.
 - 3. NICU
 - a. The mother and one support person will be allowed to visit.
 - b. No other visitors will be allowed including children under 14.
 - 4. Postpartum (Birth Place and Mother Baby)
 - a. The same two coaches from LD may stay with the patient (over 14 years old)
 - b. No other visitors are allowed including children under 14.
